In 1960 the family moved to Whiting, Indiana. As a devoted mother, Faye continually encouraged her children and always had them in Sunday School and church. Her love for dealing with people kept her working as a waitress, in Hammond, Indiana.

Faye was a best friend to her children and uncommonly generous to others. She shared her love in countless ways and planted hope into many lives.

Faye met Lyndal “Smitty” Smith and was married to him on October 22, 1977. They made their residence in Hammond, Indiana. Smitty worked for Inland Steel as a porter/cook on the ore boats and Faye soon applied for a Licensed Seaman’s Card, so that she too could work, as a porter on the boats. Faye and Smitty bought their dream home in Knoxville in 1987, where they wintered, until they retired together in October of 1993.

Faye Beryl Smith passed on December 23, 1995, at 7:23 PM in Vanderbilt Hospital, Nashville, Tennessee.
